

On January 23, 2022, Kenya signed an extension agreement with the Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) and the World Rally Championship granting us the right to host the WRC Safari Rally until December 2023, having lost the first year of our previous agreement (2020) to COVID-19 pandemic.

The second amendment, signed on the same day, further extended the hosting of the competition in Kenya until December 2026.

These extensions signify the confidence that FIA and WRC have in Kenya's ability to host a world-class event and speaks of our close partnership that has seen the growth of motorsports in Kenya, especially among women and the youth.

The Safari Rally is one of the flagship projects of His Excellency Uhuru Kenyatta, the President of the Republic of Kenya, who played a key role in its return in 2021, after a 19-year hiatus; a promise that he pledged in 2013, and kept.









Introduction

Thanks to His Excellency, the government has reaffirmed its commitment to the WRC circuit and promises to fund the project in Kenya for the next five (5) years and beyond.

In keeping with Kenya's intent to lead and deliver on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), we have developed two (2) legacy projects to secure environmental

sustainability and improve the conditions of our host institutions and host Counties.

These legacy projects are anchored on two themes: **environmental conservation** and **action for road safety**.

The **environmental conservation project** targets Kenya's wetlands affected by climate change, deforestation, Safari Rally and Kenya Motor Sports Federation routes, the service park and the spectator stage at the Moi International Sports Centre, Kasarani, with a target of planting 18 million trees in three years. Already we are approaching the 3 million mark thanks to our dedication to combating the adverse effects of climate change and especially deforestation.

We are also working with FIA on the **Action for Road Safety Program**, launched in support of the UN Decade of Action for Road Safety with a focus on Road Safety and Motoring Education. This program will bolster the safety prerogatives put in place by the Safari Safety, Security and Medical teams.

Additionally, we have opened a rally office in Finland to coordinate the WRC Safari Rally activities with potential competitors, teams, and sponsors in Europe and promote Kenyan's quality coffee.

Safari Rally is at the heart of our national heritage and as a government, we would like to welcome you all to this year's competition, TO BE HELD IN Naivasha. This will be a great opportunity for you to witness this spectacular event and experience the unique Kenyan culture.

SHAKEDOWN LOLDIA 5.40 KM




The Ndulele Conservancy off the Moi North Lake road will be the venue for the Shakedown in April 2022 from 12.00hrs.

Undulating tracks with varying surfaces through a wooded landscape will allow the crews to sample in minor what will be the 2022 ARC Safari Rally and their first feel of the spectacular challenge ahead.

Shakedown will be run adjacent to the Loldia airstrip along the Moi North Lake. Spectators will be able to access the Shakedown through a Spectator Entry gate which will lead them to a secure parking location from where they can walk comfortably to the appointed Spectator area. Loldia is a Wildlife conservancy and absolutely.

No walking beyond the Spectator Zone will be allowed in the interest of safety.

To this end, only spectators in Vehicles will be permitted through the entry point.

1.Obey the organizers' instructions. If people are asked by the Route marshals to leave dangerous place on the SS route, they should follow these instructions. In case of indiscipline the special stage will be canceled!



2.Especially dangerous locations are marked as "PROHIBITED AREA" or "NO GO AREA". Do not try to enter these places, they can be terminally unsafe! Do not stand on "escape roads" as well. Do not cross the safety tape or net and stay behind it!



3.Keep the distance from the edge of the roadway. Keep in mind the high speed of competing cars. It is impossible to eliminate either the driver's mistake or an unpredictable technical defect of the vehicle.










4. Don't sit by the SS route.
Always watch, what's happening on the special stage. Think of quick evacuation of your place, at any time keep prepared an escape way and be prepare for quick reaction



5. Avoid places below level of the route. Do not stand on outer sides of curves, in front of houses or other impassable obstacles. In forest do not stand in front of the trees. For watching the competition shoose only places on elevated areas, behind solid obstacles etc.

7. If you take the children to the rally, keep them under careful and constant view. Adults are fully responsible for childrens' safety!

Do not cross the roadway and do not walk on the SS route during special stage! Take the position for watching the rally before start of first rally crews, not during the SS run



8. Avoid driving on access roads upstream of competition vehicles approaching the SS during the rally. Roadways to the special stages are often narrow and racers could be in hurry.

- Do not park where you could stand in the way of competing crews, service staff and other participants of public traffic.

- Don't throw anything on the route it could endanger the safety of passing competing crews. This behaviour is also handled in the Criminal Code!

- Count with time limits take a look on the Rally guide in advance, when the SS route is giong to be closed before the start and re-opened after the end.
 Remember that the route SS is not re-opened until the Organizer's vehicle passage.
